- 3. **RESIDENTS OF ALL OTHER NYS COUNTIES -** PRESENT THE **NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT, PHOTO ID, AND PROOF OF RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS** TO YOUR COUNTY TREASURER (WHO WILL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCE), MAIL OR BRING THE CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCE TO THE BURSAR'S OFFICE

TO QUALIFY FOR THE NEW YORK STATE RESIDENT TUITION RATE, YOU MUST HAVE LEGALLY RESIDED IN NEW YORK STATE FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS.
